MASA Parade Judging Guidelines

- Qualifications to be eligible to be judged in the parade
 - Each motorized unit or club must participate in the MAASMC competition to be eligible to be judged in the MASA parade.
 - Eligibility for the competition includes completed forms and fees paid
 - Dues & Competition Entry
 - Participation by a club or unit includes an entry into drill competition, obstacle course, slow race, or show vehicle competition.
 - Shrine Center motor corps/motor patrols with multiple vehicle types count as separate entries into competition and parade judging. (Example—Shrine Center Motor Corps is comprised of motorcycles, mini cars, and show cars. Each group of vehicles counts as a separate entry. Each show vehicle counts as a separate entry)
- Judging of units/clubs performed by MAASMC Officers or Past Presidents
 - Where will judges be stationed?
 - Intersection of Atlantic Avenue and 21st Street
 - Signage alerting clubs/units
 - Motor Corps Parade Judging Ahead
 - Motor Corps Parade Judging Zone
- Classes
 - 2-wheel vehicles including 3 wheel licensed vehicles
 - 3-wheel vehicles
 - Non-Licensed
 - 4-wheel vehicles
 - Mini 18 Wheelers
 - With or without trailers
 - Show Vehicles-
 - Only the show vehicle that enters the MAASMC show vehicle competition is eligible to be judged
- How will we judge?
 - 2-wheel, 3 wheel, 4-wheel—must perform a figure 8 and a maneuver of choice
 - 18 Wheelers—presentation/maneuver of choice
 - Show Vehicles—overall presentation
- Awards/Winners
 - Will be presented at the MASA Beach Bash on Saturday after the parade
